

## Elwood family gift to be invested directly in lives of Olivet's students

Olivet Nazarene University recently received a significant gift to encourage success and leadership in the lives of its students. In recognition of the life and legacy of alumnus Dr. David L. Elwood, a longtime Columbus, Indiana resident, this gift — given by Dr. Elwood's family — is a direct investment in future generations of Olivetians. It is designated to expand and strengthen the programming of the Center for Student Success, as well as to coordinate and strengthen various leadership efforts in the new Elwood Leadership Program.

In further recognition, the University will rename the current Center and dedicate it as the David L. Elwood Center for Student Success on October 31, 2014, during Olivet's Homecoming and Family Weekend.

The Elwood family gift also honors the University where Dr. Elwood's faith and values were firmly established. "David Elwood represents what we celebrate as an Olivet community," said Dr. John C. Bowling, University president, when announcing the gift to the campus community on October 1, 2014. "His life reminds us that success is not just about the bottom line. More importantly, it's about a life of service, faithfulness, family and achieving a higher purpose."

Dr. Elwood graduated from Olivet in 1955 with a degree in psychology. There, he met and fell in love with his future wife, Ella (Jones). He and Ella married in 1956. Later, he earned advanced degrees from two other universities. He enjoyed a successful career as a psychologist, and she was a top performer in her real estate career. But that was just the beginning of their unfolding life of significance and success.

In 1980, he and his son, Mark, founded Elwood Staffing®, and Dr. Elwood continues to serve as chairman of the board.
